ORDER

The institutions mentioned in the table under para 3 below had submitted applications to the Western Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to B.Ed. in terms of Section 14(1) and 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The WRC at its 90<sup>th</sup> meeting held from 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2006 at Bhopal considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording etc. and the institutions compliance reports on deficiencies found the institutions mentioned in para 3 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to these institutions for the course and intake mentioned against their names as under:

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength for the sanctioned B.Ed. (Open) course and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulations 2005. For an intake of 500 students or less the minimum core faculty for the course at the Hqrs. level will comprise one Professor, one Reader and four Lecturers.
- The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.

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- (e) That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
- (f) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
- (g) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (h) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
- (i) The institutions intending to run the teachers training programme approved above in rented premises are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.
5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. The NCTE Hqrs. May also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.
6. It is mandatory for the institutions to complete 180 teaching days as such the concerned university/board should ensure the recognition granted as per NCTE regulations and if the recognition date did not match with the academic calendar then the recognition granted shall be effective from the ensuing academic session.

(D.E.) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 500 students followed by order F.NRC/NCTE/RJ-144/288<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2018/197448 dated 09<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 granting permission to the University for change of its name from **Kota Open University, Kota, Rajasthan to Vardhman Mahaveer Open University, Kota, Rajasthan**. Initial recognition granted by NRC is continuing and stands valid for the academic year 2023-24 & onwards till it is withdrawn.
