### **C-1.1 Choice Based Credit System and Online Course:**

- (i) Non-professional Graduate (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.) and Post Graduate (M.A./M.Sc.) programmes will offer choice based credit courses for students in their final year. Students may opt any one paper from the list given in the admission brochure in lieu of any one paper of his/her main subjects. The credits and grade points earned will be accommodated in the marksheet with a remark “CBCS Paper”.
  
- (ii)(a) Non-professional graduate (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.) and Post Graduate (M.A./M.Sc.) programmes will provide students an opportunity to opt an online course from the list of MOOCs at SWAYAM Platform of MHRD, Govt. of India. Credits earned while doing online course will be accommodated with the main course.
  
- (b) At graduation level, maximum two papers will be accommodated in lieu of his/her original paper(s), while only one paper will be allowed to be replaced by the online course at post graduate level.
  
- (c) The online course through SWAYAM will be allowed in the complete duration of a course; however, students will have to inform the University about his/her online course in advance, and about the subject and paper(s) in lieu of which the online course will be chosen.
  
- (iii) The University will also provide online courses in the programmes currently run by the University in accordance with the rules/regulations led by the UGC/MHRD, Govt. of India/State Govt.

The examination of such online courses will be conducted online in conformity with the policy of UGC/MHRD. Other provisions will be same as in the case of specific courses being provided offline.

The Online programmes comprise of online (i) admission, (ii) delivery of study material, (iii) submission of assignments and (iv) term end examination along with assessment of submitted assignments and answer sheets of term end examinations.

The Course and fee will be same as in the case of existing open mode courses of the University. Other provisions will also be the same.
